Urlacher has participated in Sex Offender Treatment Programs. In 2011, Urlacher was found to be a Sexually Violent Predator (SVP) and civilly committed at the Special Commitment Center on McNeil Island. In 2020, Urlacher was found eligible to be released to a Less Restrictive Alternative (LRA) placement at the Secure Community Transitional Facility (SCTF) on McNeil Island. Due to his sexual criminal history, Urlacher has been classified a Level 3 sex offender. Due to URLACHER sexual criminal history he has been classified as a level 3 Sex Offender allowing the Pierce County Sheriff's Department to disclose relevant, necessary, and accurate information to the public. In 2005, Charles Urlacher was convict necessary, of a Child in the 1st Degree and Rape of a Child in the 2nd degree in Pierce County Superior Court. Ct. I: According to official documents, between 07/04/1998 and 08/31/1998, Urlacher (ages 44-45) sexually assaulted an 11-year-old non-familial male acquaintance. In 1995, Urlacher was convicted of Assault in the 4th Degree in Pierce County Superior Court. According to official documents, Urlacher (age 40) sexually assaulted a 12-year-old non-familial female acquaintance.

Sex offender laws allow for the tracking of offenders. The laws do not control the location of where and offender chooses to live or where they choose to obtain education.

In Washington state there are over 20,000 convicted sex offenders eligible for registration. There are currently over 2,600 registered sex offenders in Pierce County.

This information is meant to educate you about offenders in our community. It has not been made available for you to act against any individual. Please report all information on offenders directly to law enforcement. Those individuals seeking to harass, harm or confront an offender can be arrested and prosecuted.
